The Soft Coral Capital of the World Dive the Colorful Islands of Fiji

Join Team Ninja October 20, 2018 as we head to the islands of Fiji for a week long liveboard expedition in the Soft Coral Capital of the World. Over the course of the week we'll enjoy some of the most colorful drift diving in the world. As we explore the reefs of Nigali Pass, Wakaya, and the Kadavu islands we expect to spot a remarkable variety of both pelagic and macro life including eagle rays, mantas, silvertips, hammerheads, leopard sharks, giant groupers, turtles, pygmy seahorses, mantis shrimp, nudibranchs and so much more.

During the trip we will also make a land excursion to a remote Fijian village to get a taste of local culture and traditions. While visiting the village we will have the opportunity to participate in a traditional kava ceremony and see a warrior dance.

Fiji is located in the middle of the Pacific Ocean, just west of Tonga and consists of more than 300 islands, only about 1/3 of which are populated. However, as remote as this exotic diving destination seems, Fiji is easily accessible with affordable flights out of several major cities readily available.

For this expedition, we have chartered the M/V Fiji Aggressor, a luxury liveboard built to accommodate smaller groups of 10 divers, making it perfect for those of us who like a more intimate liveboard experience. The Fiji Aggressor has air conditioning in all indoor areas, and boasts a spacious salon with multiple screens, making it the perfect place to view your photos and videos between dives. All meals are included as well as a selection of local beers and wines.

We set sail from Suva aboard the M/V Fiji Aggressor, an extremely seaworthy liveboard vessel designed with ocean research in mind. She holds 5 double staterooms with private bathrooms, full air conditioning, has great food, full nitrox service, and an amazing crew. The trip spans a total of 8 days including 6 days of diving with up to 5 dives a day including night dives. What's included?

Accommodation, +/- 27 dives, tanks, air, weights, all meals (full breakfast, lunch, dinner & dessert), beverages (incl. beer & wine), morning & afternoon snacks, linen service, towels, land excursion for Kava & Warrior ceremony, and on-board facilities.

Itinerary:

Throughout the week aboard the Fiji Aggressor guests will depart Suva to explore the reefs, bommies and walls of Nigali Pass, Wakaya, Koro and Namenalala Islands. Known as the soft coral capital, the brilliant colors on display will dazzle even the most experienced divers and photographers. Drift dives with eagle rays, mantas, turtles, sharks and giant groupers are also on the itinerary. Clownfish, pygmy seahorses, ornate ghost pipefish, and a multitude of nudibranchs bring smiles to every dive! To top off the exiting diving and experience some of Fiji's local culture, a visit to a Fijian village on one of the remote islands is arranged including a Kava ceremony and warrior dance. All guests are required to wear a traditional sulu (sarong or wrap) so either bring your own or we will gladly provide one for you!

With all dives from the mother ship, five dives a day are the norm. Diving begins Sunday morning and ends Friday before lunch when the Fiji Aggressor returns to port. The crew hosts a sunset cocktail party at 6:00 p.m. followed by dinner ashore. Saturday morning check out is at 7:30 am. Transportation can be scheduled for guests to the Suva Nausori Airport (SUV) or a local hotel.

Trip Registration Terms

Once we receive your per-registration request online a member of the Dive Ninjas team will contact you to secure your space. In the meantime we will place a tentative hold on the requested spaces for your booking for up to 72 hours. However, due to this being a limited offer trip with only 10 spaces available reservations can only be guaranteed upon receipt of a minimum 20% deposit. Once the deposit is received your space is 100% secured. After the deposit is made the additional payments can be made as outlined below or you can make payments sooner and/or in larger amounts if you prefer.

Minimum Payments Schedule:

- A minimum 20% deposit is due to reserve a space on the trip
- Additional 20% due 9 months before the departure date
- Additional 20% due 6 months before the departure date
- Remaining balance due 90 days before the departure date

Expedition Cost:

Double Occupancy Stateroom (10 spaces available): \$3295 USD/person*
* Prices do not include sales tax/IVA

Any additional costs?

Each guest must pay a Port fee of \$300 and a Namena Park fee of \$20 per person on-board. The Fiji Aggressor accepts cash, Visa & MasterCard. Refunds & Cancellations:

We understand that some times plans change or things pop up. If for any reason you need to cancel your trip we will try our best to fill your space so that we may offer you a full refund minus a \$200 USD administration fee. However, if a reservation is canceled and we can not fill your reserved space, if the cancellation was made....

- 12 – 9 months prior to departure, 20% of the trip price is forfeit.
- 9 – 5 months prior to departure, 30% of the trip price is forfeit.
- 4 – 3 months prior to departure, 50% of the trip price is forfeit.
- 90 days or less prior to departure, 100% of the trip price is forfeit.
